

Talking with Visitors at Fun Day

Our goal: Help every visitor feel welcomed, seen, and cared for.

We are not trying to force conversations. We are looking for natural open doors.

The Four Conversation Levels

Level	Purpose	Example
Casual	Help people relax	“How did you hear about today?”
Meaningful	Show real interest	“How are you finding life in this area?”
Spiritual	Gently explore faith	“Have you had much to do with Christian things?”
Jesus	Point to Jesus	“Would it be okay if I shared what Jesus has done for me?”

1. Casual Questions

- How did you hear about today?
- Have you been to anything here before?
- Are your children enjoying the activities?
- Which school do your children go to?
- Did you come with friends or family today?
- What has been your favourite part of the day so far?

2. Meaningful Questions

- What do your children enjoy doing?
- What has helped your family feel connected here?
- Is there anything your family has been looking for locally — activities, support, community?
- What do you enjoy about living around here?

Good follow-up phrases:

- “That sounds like a big change.”
- “How has that been for you?”
- “That must be hard.”
- “What has helped?”
- “How are you going with that?”

3. Spiritual Questions

- Did you know this event is sponsored by a church? We enjoy bringing people together to meet their neighbours.
- Have you had much to do with Christian things?
- What has your experience of church been like?
- Are your children enrolled in a Scripture class? Which one? How do they like it?

4. Jesus Conversations

- Is there anything we could pray for you or your family? Could I pray for that now?
- Would you be interested in getting together sometime so I could hear more about your spiritual journey?
- I learnt something interesting about prayer last week. Can I share it with you?
- Would it be okay if I shared briefly what Jesus means to me?
